## Updated COVID-19 Sick Policy

Students or staff who have tested positive for or have symptoms consistent with COVID-19 need to consult CDC guidelines and their medical provider for home isolation direction and report it to the school office immediately.

Symptoms may include:

- Fever or chills
- New or unexplained cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, or runny nose
- New or unexplained muscle aches, headache, fatigue, nausea/vomiting or diarrhea
- New or unexplained change in your sense of taste or smell

If you have symptoms consistent with COVID-19 but **DO NOT** think you have COVID-19 you may return to school when you:

- Remain fever, diarrhea, and vomiting free for 24 hours without use of fever, diarrhea or vomiting suppressing medication **AND** all other symptoms have significantly improved.

If you have had exposure to someone with COVID-19, you should closely monitor symptoms and follow the latest CDC/Pima County Health Department guidelines.
